BUS VARIANCE BLACKOUT DATES FOR FALL 2019

This is a reminder that Bus Transportation Variances DO NOT carry over from year to year. <u>A new variance must be completed each school year</u>. If you require your child to ride a different bus than their home bus route for the 2019-2020 school year, you must complete a new variance form.

 This means, parents who need to send their child via bus to/from daycare, babysitters, etc. during the 19-20 school year, must submit the *Request for Transportation Variance* to the St. Robert School office no later than Friday, <u>August 9, 2019</u> to be approved and in effect for the first day of school.

Please be aware that no bus variances will be processed or granted between Monday, August 12, 2019 and Friday, September 6, 2019 as bus routes become finalized. Parents who do not complete a bus variance form by the August 9th deadline must wait until they are again accepted on September 9, 2019.

Variances will not be processed between August 12, 2019 and September 6, 2019. Your child will be allowed only on their home bus route until the blackout period ends on September 9th.

Also, please note that any 19/20 bus variance forms received on September 9th or later require a processing time of <u>3 days</u> prior to the variance taking effect.
