WE NEED YOUR HELP! — As we navigate the different protocol and guidelines to keep our kids safe and healthy, we have found that we are currently extremely limited in what the kids can use during recess. The protocol that we need to follow prevents a basketball or soccer ball from being shared among different grades. It has been suggested that to maintain contact tracing, EACH grade needs their own "recess tote". These totes would be filled with footballs, basketballs, soccer balls, kick balls and jump ropes. At the completion of recess each day, the play items would be sanitized according to health department guidelines and returned to the tote for the next day's recess. We expect each tote, including the play items, to cost approximately \$100; total cost about \$1000 for all grades. Now we need YOUR HELP! We are asking families to donate anything they can to help! \$5, \$10, \$20 ... once we have received all of the donations, we will be able to purchase the play items and bins so that the kids have something to do to burn off their energy each day at recess!
