POWERSCHOOL PARENT PORTAL – We are now able to provide you with access to your child's current grades and attendance via PowerSchool. PowerSchool's Parent Portal is a tool specifically developed for parents and students that integrates into the PowerSchool Student Information System (SIS). Before you can log in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal, you will need to create your account and link your child(ren) to it. A letter providing you with your child's Access ID and Access Password was sent home with students today. This information is needed to link a child to your account. Please contact the school office at (810) 659-2503 if you do not receive this information. The Access ID and Access Password for your child should be protected. Only provide this information to individuals who need to monitor your child's progress. The URL that you will use to access your child's grades and attendance is https://dol.clgpsedu.com/public/home.html. Please take the time to bookmark this URL. The letter you received walks you through the steps in order to access the information you will need. Feel free to contact the school office should you have any questions or concerns.

EMERGENCY CARDS – We have now completed our first three weeks of school. <u>Have you returned your child's blue emergency card and yellow health form?</u> These items are very important. Teachers use the health form in the event that students leave campus and the information on the emergency card is used in the office if your child is ill and we have to call home. Blank cards/forms are available in the school office. **Please turn your completed items in to your child's homeroom teacher by Monday, 9/21.**

EMAIL REQUEST FORMS – There are still a few families who have not returned the purple Parent Email Request form. Please send your form in on **Monday**, **9/21** if you have not already done so.

ATTENDANCE HOTLINE – Attendance and timely arrival is an important part of each student's academic performance. While it is our hope that every child would be present and on time for each and every day of school, we know that this is not always possible. Health, injury, and appointments, to name a few, sometimes prohibit school attendance/being on time. Text/Emails/Phone Calls to teachers DO NOT count as attendance notification. If your child will be absent or late, you must report that absence/tardy, before 9:00 am, by calling the St. Robert Attendance Hotline at: (810) 487-9600. Please be prepared to include the following information if your child is sick – NO MATTER WHAT TYPE OF ILLNESS:

- Your student's name and grade
- The exact symptoms the student is experiencing (fever, vomiting, cough, sore throat, etc. flu, stomach flu, cold, not feeling good are NOT acceptable symptoms)
- If a fever is present, what was the highest temperature?
- When did the symptoms start? (<u>include a specific date a few days ago or over the weekend</u> is NOT an acceptable date)
- Has the student had any known exposure to a person who tested positive for COVID-19 or who is suspected of having COVID-19?

ESP - NEW FOR 20/21 – The ESP handbook and forms were updated this fall. The forms that are needed to sign up for ESP are now included with the ESP handbook, which can be found on the school website in the Quick Links box. Please note that an ESP **RSVP** has to be filled out by <u>Sunday night</u> **each week** in order for your child to attend ESP for that week. The links for signing up for each week for the month of September can also be found on the school website.
