

## ST. ROBERT SCHOOL PARENT NEWSLETTER – Friday, April 9, 2021

**MUSTANG RAFFLE** – We are excited to share that our fundraising committee has decided to start anew and fresh this year by replacing Superdraw with the St. Robert Mustang Raffle. The Mustang Raffle will now serve as our largest and most critically important fundraiser of the school year. We believe that the Mustang Raffle, just as Superdraw did, will serve to create a strong sense of community. It will directly coincide with our annual Fr. Anthony Car Show on June 11, 2021. **The cost of each ticket is \$20 and all SOLD/UNSOLD tickets are due June 4, 2021.** The prizes for the raffle are as follows:

- **First Prize:** 2021 Mustang GT Coupe Premium (2 year/\$15,000 mi lease) or \$30,000 Cash
- **Second Prize:** \$3,000 Cash

Please be advised that each family will be receiving an envelope with 10 tickets enclosed. We are requiring that each family sell all 10 tickets. If any of the 10 allotted tickets are not sold, the dollar amount of the total remaining tickets will be added to tuition for the 21/22 school year.

- We are getting a discount by ordering early. **The cost of the planner will go up to \$6.00 after the Wednesday, 4/14 deadline.**
- Our planner order will be submitted after school on Wednesday, 4/14 so that we can receive the discount. **Any planners ordered after the Wednesday, April 14, 2021 deadline will cost \$6.00.**
- This planner is a required school supply for all students who will be in grades 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> for the 21/22 school year.
