#### CALENDAR REMINDERS

All of us at St. Robert School pray that you and your families enjoy a safe, happy and blessed Thanksgiving. **ATTENDANCE REMINDER** – Absences and tardies for all students (Preschool 3 and 4, Young Fives, Kdg and 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) need to be called in to the Attendance Hotline (810) 487-9600 each time they occur. Texts/Emails/Phone Calls to teachers are fine as a courtesy, but **DO NOT** count as attendance notification. You still need to report the absence/tardy through the Attendance Hotline.

**WINTER REMINDERS** – The snow is flying and the temperatures are dropping! Hats, mittens/gloves and warm coats are a necessity!

- Students MUST have a coat on if the temperature is below 40 degrees. Hooded sweatshirts are not an option for a coat.
- Winter boots are required if there is snow on the ground. No students will be allowed on the snow in their regular shoes.
- Students in PK-4 may not be in the snow without snow pants, hats, and gloves.
- Winter boots may not be worn in the classroom. Ankle height boots may be worn in the classroom if they are not winter boots.
- No bare legs are allowed with skirts. Legs must be covered by tights or leggings. The leggings must be solid in color and must be black, navy blue or white.

**SCHOOL CLOSINGS** – We typically use School Messenger as our text communication system. We will no longer use that program. We will instead be using Remind. We're in the midst with getting an all school Remind set up, but it will take a week or two to transfer the information to them. In the meantime, if we have inclement weather and need to close school, your homeroom teacher will send you a Remind message, we will post on Facebook, the news channels and Mrs. Bushey will send an all school email.
