

# TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

(FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment)



**The deadline to apply for tuition assistance is Monday, March 2, 2026.**

\*All applications and supporting documents must be submitted or uploaded by 3/2/26. Late applications and documents will not be accepted.

The application should only be filled out and submitted once per family. You will be automatically considered for all of the programs based on the info submitted on your application if submitted by the **3/2/26 deadline**.

- **Diocesan Scholarship:** Open to any family with a Catholic student (or students) entering grades K-8 (Up to \$800) and 9-12 (Up to \$1,100), in a Diocese of Lansing Catholic school, who is of the Catholic faith, and whose home parish is in the Diocese of Lansing. Family must show a financial need.
- **New Family Grants:** Designed to support Catholic families who are seeking a Catholic education within the Diocese of Lansing and are enrolling children for the first time at either the elementary or high school level. Families may qualify for both grants at the same time if they are new to both the elementary and high school levels. The maximum award is \$1,500 per family, regardless of the number of children enrolling.
  - New Family Elementary Grant – Grades K-8 (\$500)
  - New Family High School Grant – Grades 9-12 (\$1,000)
- **The Venerable Augustus Tolton Scholarship (\$500):** In addition to the grant criteria for all grants, the student must also be African American or Black and show a need of at least \$500 over and above the \$800/\$1,100 need shown for the Diocesan Scholarship.
- **The Saint Jose Luis Sanchez del Rio Scholarship (\$500):** In addition to the grant criteria for all grants, the student must also be Hispanic and show a need of at least \$500 over and above the \$800/\$1,100 need shown for the Diocesan Scholarship.

<b><i>New Families</i></b>	Families new to St. Robert who register after the March 2, 2026 deadline will still be considered for parish tuition assistance. Contact the school office to obtain access to the application. Complete the application online, upload the required supporting documentation to FACTS, and pay the processing fee.

**All applications need to be processed online at <https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>**

Applications can only be completed online. Paper applications will not be accepted.

All supporting documentation must be uploaded through the FACTS online form.

- Copies of your most recent Federal Tax forms including all supporting tax schedules and W2's.
- Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Worker's Compensation and TANF.
- If the family owns a business, Federal Tax forms from 23/24 and 24/25 must be submitted.

You will receive a determination email by May 30<sup>th</sup>.
