What is the Superdraw?

The Superdraw is our biggest annual fundraiser and has been a St. Robert tradition for nearly 25 years. While tuition covers a large portion of the cost of educating our students, it does not fully cover everything needed to run a strong, faith-filled school. Superdraw helps bridge that gap by supporting school costs not fully covered by tuition, such as classroom supplies, enrichment programs, and operations. These funds help keep tuition stable and support our mission of a high-quality Catholic education that we value so deeply.

When and where is Superdraw?

The event will be held on **March 14, 2026** in the **St. Robert School Activity Center**. Guests must be 21 years or older to attend.

Who organizes the fundraiser?

The event is organized by the PTO in collaboration with school/church administration and volunteers.

How can families participate?

Families can participate by attending the event, donating items to a raffle or auction, selling tickets, and/or volunteering their time before, during, or after the event (clean up the next day).

Do I need to sell tickets?

Yes! Only 1,000 tickets are printed, and all 1,000 tickets must be sold. Every year, we ask each family to sell **at least** 5 tickets. Without ticket sales, there is no Superdraw!

What if selling tickets is difficult for our family?

If your family is unable to sell all of your tickets, there are opportunities to sell tickets in the community such as after Mass or in the lobby at Bueche's.

What if I can't attend the event?

You can still support by making a donation (sponsorship or auction item), sharing the event information with others, or supporting the various planning committees prior to the event.

What should I wear?

Think casual and comfortable—what you'd wear for a night out with friends. Jeans, sweaters, and casual shirts are all great choices. Feeling lucky? Add some St. Patrick's Day flair—completely optional!

What can I expect during the event?

Enjoy a mix of social time, great food, cash bar, and fundraising moments. Many families say it's a great chance to meet other parents and feel more connected to the school community. Seating is open for all guests, except for those sponsors who have reserved tables.
